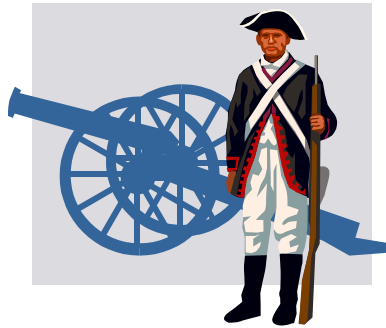

**CANNON SHENANIGANS and  
NEW HAMPSHIRE'S MUSTER DAY TRADITIONS**



**New Hampshire's Muster Day tradition ended in 1850, as did the related localized rivalries of stealing cannons, particularly near the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Muster Day was a time of drills, marching, and sham battles for local militias in New Hampshire. This spectator event was accompanied by entertainers, vendors, gamblers, and a great deal of alcohol.**
