**“A Musical Evening With Thomas Edison”**

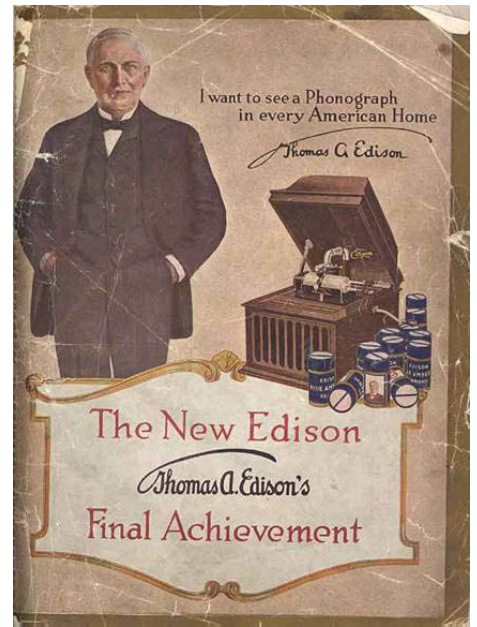
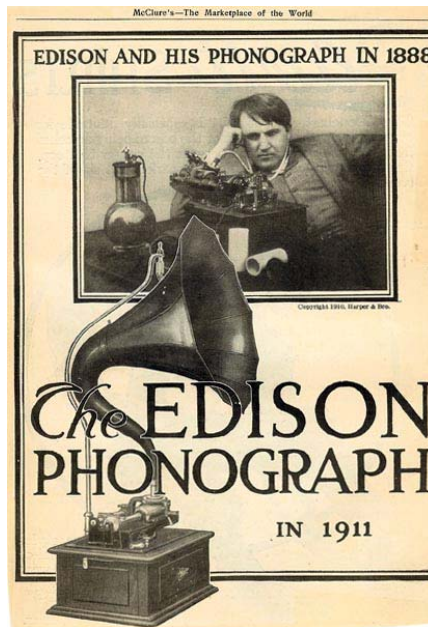
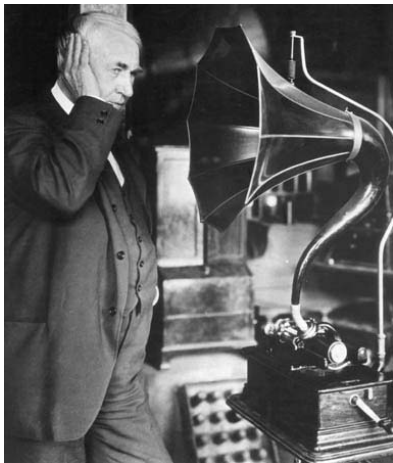
**Presented by: Roger Daniels**
