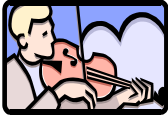


# MUSIC IN THE SPRING FESTIVAL

Rodney Miller is considered to be the foremost exponent of New England style fiddling. He has been designated as a "Master Fiddler" by the National Endowment for the Arts. He has toured the world, and recorded 10 albums

David Surette is one of New England's finest guitarists. A top player of the Celtic fingerstyle guitar, his repertoire includes a range from original compositions to blues, ragtime, and folk music. David is also the head of the folk department at the Concord Community Music School.
