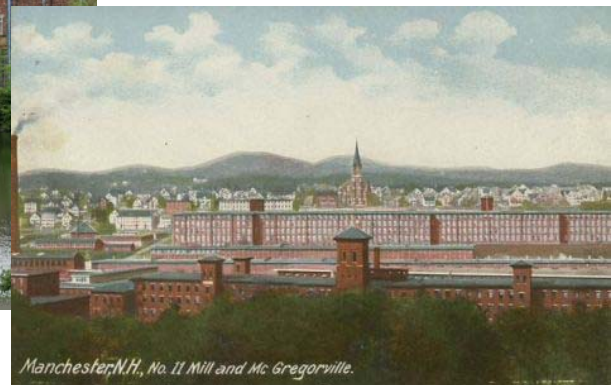

**“The Mills of Manchester, New Hampshire and
Manchester, England”**

Compare industrialization and the lives of workers in northwest England with New England. The comparison of the forms industrialization took and the different experiences of workers in the two countries sheds light on the era of industrialization in New Hampshire, particularly at the Amoskeag Mill in Manchester.

Ph. D., University of Pittsburgh; M.A.T., Yale; taught English history at Trenton State College; teaching in Lancaster, England added to her specialty in Victorian and labor history.
