There are two hour-long tours that can each accommodate up to twelve people – 11:00 and 12:15. While one group is on tour, the other can explore the Currier Art Museum, have lunch (there is a café there) and visit the gift shop. We are planning on leaving Manchester at 3:00pm.

**ZIMMERMAN HOUSE TOURS**

The Frank Lloyd Wright-designed Zimmerman House is the only residence in New England designed by the architect open to the public. It is managed by the Currier Museum of Art.

Wright designed the Zimmerman House in his classic Usonian style in 1950, planning its gardens, its built-in and freestanding furniture, its textiles, and even the mailbox. The Zimmerman House offers a glimpse into the 1950s - 1960s, and the private lives of Isadore and Lucille Zimmerman, who lived in the home for 36 years.
